Assembly Instructions

FOR TACO MARINE LEANING POSTS

- Search for the eight pre-drilled holes by feeling for them on the non-cushion / marine lumber side of the back rest. Mark the cloth when a hole is discovered.
- 2. Align the holes on the round pads of the swivel arms with the marks made on the cloth.
- 3. Install the eight machine screws that are provided four screws for left arm and four screws for the right arm. Place a screw through the hole of the round pad located at the end of the swivel arms and fasten each screw onto the pre-drilled holes of the marine lumber.
- 4. Once the left and right swivel arms are installed onto the backrest, the swivel arms will align with the two outer-most rod holders on the TACO Marine Leaning Post. When not in use, the swivel arms may be folded in for the convenience of storage.

NOTE: If mounting in areas with no pre-drilled holes, please use the provided wood screws instead of the machine screws.

FOR OTHER LEANING POSTS

- 1. Take measurements to suit the backrest. Measure the distance between the two rod holders where you plan to place the right and left swivel arms of backrest.
- 2. Follow steps 3 4 above.

8 MACHINE SCREWS (A):

1/4" DIAMETER , 1" LONG, WITH A 20 THREAD COUNT

(TO BE USED WHEN DESIRED MOUNTING IS OUTER POSITION IN PRE- DRILLED HOLES)

8 WOOD SCREWS (B):

1/4" DIAMETER , 1" LONG, WITH A 10 THREAD COUNT

(TO BE USED WHEN DESIRED MOUNTING IS INNER POSITION)
